At our state’s capitol recently, legislators were forced to abandon three disastrous proposals: the flat tax income tax cut, TABOR limits, and a raid on the voter protected funds, because of advocates for children like you. Last Friday, House Speaker Kirk Adams and Senate President Bob Burns had agreed with Governor Brewer on a budget package that included the spending plan and property tax cuts, but also included putting a temporary sales tax increase on the November ballot for voters to decide. *Young Ones United* applauds the vision of the senators and representatives who voted NO on the budget for the sake of Arizona’s future. Now, thanks to the Governor’s veto, lawmakers have another chance to craft a comprehensive and bipartisan fiscal solution for our state. We look forward to working with legislators and Governor Brewer toward a budget that tightens the purse strings without strangling our future
